**TODAY LET US TAKE A LOOK AT THE A TO Z for
PRAISING GOD:**

A – He is our ABBA Father. He is indeed the Father we all have been looking for all our lives!! It is indeed so comforting to know that God is our Abba Father and He loves us with a perfect love.

Romans 8:15 says, “For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.”

B – He is our Burden Bearer. God is always there waiting for us to take everything that concerns & burdens us and bring it to Him and surrender it to Him.

Psalms 55:22 says, “Cast your burden on the LORD, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.”

1 Peter 5:6-7 says, “Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.”

Also, Messiah says in **Matthew 11:28-30,** “Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”

C – The God we serve is the Creator of the Universe and everything in it. He is indeed the Creator of the Macrocosm, Microcosm and the Metacosm.

Genesis 1:1 says- “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

Isaiah 40:28 says, “Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.”

D – The Lord is our Deliverer.

Psalms 18:2 says, “The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.”

E – Our God is Eternal. Time does not exist for Him because He exists outside of time. He is forever and there is no end to Him.

Isaiah 26:4 says, “Trust in the LORD forever, For in YAH, the LORD, is everlasting strength.”

Jeremiah 10:10 says, “But the LORD is the true God; he is the living God and the eternal King.”

F – Our God is Faithful and He is a Fortress!

1 Corinthians 1:9 says, “God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Hebrews 10:23 says, “Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.”

2 Samuel 22:2 says, "The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer."

Psalms 91:2 says, "I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."

G – God is Gentle.

Matthew 11:29 says, "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

2 Corinthians 10:1 says, "Now I, Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ—who in presence am lowly among you, but being absent am bold toward you."

H – Our God is Holy. Our God is Holy and set apart from His Creation. And as such He alone is worthy of all the glory and honor and praise.

Revelation 4:8 says, "The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"

Isaiah 6:3 says, "And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"

I – God is Immutable. He is indeed unchangeable, and all of His promises are Yes and Amen in Him.

Malachi 3:6 says, "For I am the LORD, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob."

James 1:17 says, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning."

Hebrews 13:8 says, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

J – God is YHWH Jireh "The Lord will provide"

Genesis 22:14 says, "And Abraham called the name of the place, The-LORD-Will-Provide; as it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the LORD it shall be provided."

K – He is King. He is the King of Kings, the Everlasting King.

Psalms 5:2 says, "Give heed to the voice of my cry, My King and my God, For to You I will pray."

This scripture is written about Messiah- Revelation 19:16 says, "On his robe and on his thigh He has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS."

L – God Is Love and He is Lord. The Lord of Lords!!

1 John 4:8-10 says, "He who does not love does not know God, for God is love. In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

Revelation 17:14 says, "These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful."

Acts 2:36 says, "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."

1 Timothy 6:15 says, "which He will manifest in His own time, He who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords."

M – God is the Messiah.

John 4:24-26 says, "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things." Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."

John 1:41 says, "He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated, the Christ)."

N – God is always Near. He is Omnipresent. No other being on earth, above or below can be in every place all the time. Regardless of what you are facing today- He is there in the midst.

Psalms 119:149-151 says, "Hear my voice according to Your lovingkindness; O LORD, revive me according to Your justice. They draw near who follow after wickedness; They are far from Your law. You are near, O LORD, And all Your commandments are truth."

Psalms 145:18 says, "The LORD is near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth."

O – God is Omniscient. Many times, we start feeling that there is perhaps none who understand us!! But that is NOT True. Because, God understands you and me more than we imagine: because He knows everything about you and me. Has anyone ever lied about you and you feel as if no one will ever believe you? God knows the truth. This is the most important thing. Wait for His vindication.

Psalms 135:14 says, “For the LORD will vindicate his people and have compassion on his servants.”

Psalms 139:1-6 says, “O LORD, You have searched me and known me. You know my sitting down and my rising up; You understand my thought afar off. You comprehend my path and my lying down, And are acquainted with all my ways. For there is not a word on my tongue, But behold, O LORD, You know it altogether. You have hedged me behind and before, And laid Your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is high, I cannot attain it.

P – God is Peace.

Isaiah 9:6 says, “For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”

Ephesians 2:14 says, “For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation.”

Q – God is El Qanna. He is a jealous God.

Exodus 34:14 says, “For you shall worship no other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God.” God wants all of our worship to be focused on Him and Him alone (in truth and in Spirit.)

Deuteronomy 4:24 says, "For the Lord your God is a consuming fire, a jealous God."

R – God is the Restorer of all things and He is our Redeemer. He is in the restoration business. It doesn't matter if you have moved away from Him (knowingly or unknowingly), He wants to restore the spiritual connection with you. If you do know Him & you've wandered off the path, He wants to restore your relationship with Him. Today is the day to Come back to Him!! He is our Redeemer and our Redeemer Lives!! The Garden Tomb is Empty.

Psalms 41:3 says, "The LORD will strengthen him on his bed of illness; You will sustain him on his sickbed."

Deuteronomy 30:3 says, "that the LORD your God will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you."

Titus 2:14 says, "who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works."

Ephesians 1:7 says, "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace."

1 Peter 1:18-19 says, "knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot."

S – God is Sovereign. This is one attribute of God which we really want to learn more and more about. Because the more and more we learn about God's Sovereignty in our lives, the

more we will yield to Him and lean not on our own understanding.

Daniel 4:35 says, "All the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven and among the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand or say to Him, "What have You done?"

Isaiah 43:13 says, "Indeed before the day was, I am He; And there is no one who can deliver out of My hand; I work, and who will reverse it?"

Isaiah 14:27 says, "For the LORD of hosts has purposed, And who will annul it? His hand is stretched out, And who will turn it back?"

Psalms 115:3 says, "But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases."

Proverbs 3:5-6 says, "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths."

T – God is the Teacher. Everything we ever need to know we can learn from God by being in one accord with Him, by yielding to Him and by diligently digging deeper in His Word.

John 13:13 says, "You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am."

John 14:26 says, "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you."

Psalms 25:4-5 says, "Show me Your ways, O LORD; Teach me Your paths. Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You are the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day."

Psalms 32:8 says, "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye."

Psalms 143:10 says, "Teach me to do Your will, For You are my God; Your Spirit is good. Lead me in the land of uprightness."

U – God is undefiled. There is nothing unclean, unholy or impure in Him. God is Holy, Holy, Holy!! El Elyon!! And in His presence, we are subdued by His Holiness, by His Glory. Awed by His Absolute Holiness. If we try to focus and understand about the absolute Holiness of God in the days that remain- it indeed will change the entire momentum of our walk with Messiah!!

Hebrews 7:26 says, "For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens."

V – God is our Victory. Today are you facing a battle? The Lord is the one who gives victory to His people. Just as He was victorious over sin, death and the grave, He can give that victory to you no matter the size of your Goliath.

Turn to Him in prayer and remember these verses:
1 Corinthians 15:57-58 says, "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord."

Deuteronomy 20:4 says, "for the LORD your God is He who goes with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you."

Proverbs 21:31 says, "The horse is prepared for the day of battle, But deliverance is of the LORD."

Exodus 14:14 says, "The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace."

Joshua 1:9 says, "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

W – God is Wisdom. He also gives wisdom to anyone who asks for it. We need godly wisdom to navigate through this life and to make the right decisions. The one and only way NOT to get deceived in the days that remain is by completely relying on God's wisdom as revealed in His Word.

Job 12:13 says, "With Him are wisdom and strength, He has counsel and understanding."

Proverbs 15:33 says, "The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom, And before honor is humility."

Proverbs 2:6 says, "For the LORD gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding."

Proverbs 1:7 says, "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, But fools despise wisdom and instruction."

Daniel 2:21 says, "And He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding."

James 1:5 says, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind."

X – God is eXcellent. It reflects His character and reputation of being perfect in all ways and in all things.

Psalms 8:1 says, "O Lord, our Lord, how eXcellent is Your name in all the earth, Who have set Your glory above the heavens!"

His eXcellency also is the reason He is eXalted above all things. [Psalm 148:13](#) says, "Let them praise the name of the Lord, For His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven."

Y - God is YHWH. He is Great I AM.

[Exodus 3:14](#) says, And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'

[Isaiah 12:2](#) says, "Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; 'For YAH, the LORD, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation."

Z - God is Zealous. He is very compassionate in His love and protection of His children.

[2 Kings 19:31](#) says, "For out of Jerusalem shall go a remnant, And those who escape from Mount Zion. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this."

As we together visited the A to Z of our Messiah's attributes, today is the day to bow down in humble adoration and realize that this is the same God who not only came down from Heaven, humbled Himself and was obedient to the point of death by dying an excruciating death on the Cross but this is also the same God who cares for us every day at every moment and will keep on doing that FOREVER!! What an amazing God we serve. He indeed deserves our all.

What a relief to know that Christ is with us (Hebrews 13:5, Matthew 28:20) and He is our King. Isn't that true our dear fellow brethren? What a relief to know that there is someone who cares us- And that someone is our Creator Himself!! Staggering! Staggering Indeed. What a privilege and honor we

have in the days that remain to seek Him and know Him more and more! Because the Bible says This is Eternal Life. What is Eternal Life? John 17:3 says, "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent." The Greek verb used tells us – 'To Keep on Knowing Him'.

So, let us keep on seeking Him more and more and knowing Him more and more by diligently digging deeper in His Word and let us keep honoring, worshiping and glorifying Him at all times, which is indeed our exalted privilege.
